

# NEMTAC 1008-202x – NEMT Vehicle Inspection Standard

## Standard Overview

### Standard Description

NEMTAC 1008-202x – NEMT Vehicle Inspection Standard establishes the minimum inspection criteria and procedural requirements for Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (NEMT) vehicles to ensure they meet safety, accessibility, and operational standards. This standard provides guidelines for both routine and pre-trip inspections, aimed at preventing vehicle failures that could compromise passenger safety and service reliability.

The standard includes requirements for inspecting essential vehicle components such as brakes, tires, lighting systems, securement equipment, and emergency exits. It also specifies inspection frequency, documentation, and reporting procedures, ensuring compliance with state and federal regulations, including those outlined in the FMVSS (Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards).

This standard supports NEMT providers by ensuring that vehicles are in proper working condition, meeting regulatory safety guidelines, and equipped to safely transport passengers, particularly those with mobility challenges or medical needs. It also provides a framework for maintaining records of inspections and addressing non-compliance issues.

This standard is informed by the FMVSS requirements, ensuring compliance with national vehicle safety standards, as well as the NEMT 1005-202x – Data Exchange Standard for seamless reporting and tracking of inspection data.
